<b>Criteria admission:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Are living in the community</li><li>• Have mild cognitive or physical impairment</li><li>• Have medical diagnoses and are medically stable</li><li>• Are able to look after their own personal care, or need minimum assistance (eg. with toileting, eating, medication administration)</li><li>• Are in need of a structured recreation program and are unable to access regular social opportunities in the community</li><li>• Are covered by Alberta Healthcare insurance</li><li>• Are able to function as part of a group</li><li>• Do not demonstrate behavior which may be harmful to themselves or to others</li><li>• Are manageable with the staff available</li></ul>
